

Changes to Renewal Credits

SB 402, Section 9.3(f) states, "For teachers who are in their fourth or fifth year of their current five-year license renewal cycle, the changes required by G.S. 115C-296(b)(1)b., as enacted by subsections (b)* and (c)** of this section, shall apply beginning with the first year of their next five-year license renewal cycle."

Changes to Renewal Credits SB 168 Section 5(c) effective July 1, 2017

"The State Board of Education, in consultation with local boards of education and the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina, shall (i) reevaluate and enhance the requirements for renewal of teacher licenses, and(ii) consider modifications in the license renewal achievement and to make it a mechanism for teachers to renew continually their knowledge and professional skills. skills, and (iii) integrate digital teaching and learning into the requirements for licensure renewal.

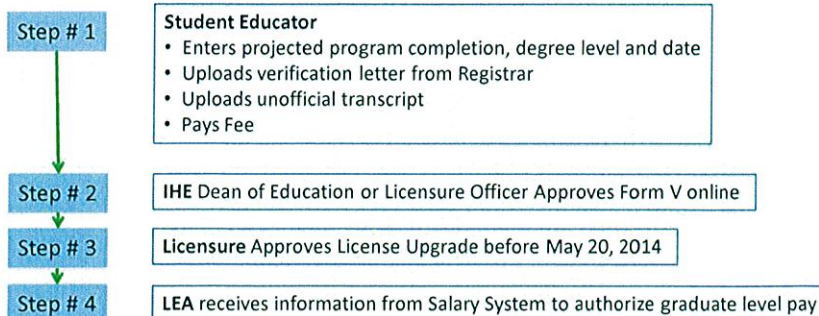
SB 402, Section 8.22 Phase Out Certain Teacher Salary Supplements “Graduate Pay”

“ Notwithstanding Section 35.11 of this act, no teachers or instructional support personnel, except for certified school nurses and instructional support personnel in positions for which a master’s degree is required for licensure, shall be paid on the “M” salary schedule or receive a salary supplement for academic preparation at the six-year degree level or at the doctoral level for the 2014-2015 school year, unless they were paid on that salary schedule or received that salary supplement prior to the 2014-2015 school year.”
